

Finding Security In An Insecure World
Ask God To Help You!
Psalm 5

Lesson One: In the face of hard things, we can be **confident** that our Father God hears our voice.

“Give ear to my words, O LORD, consider my sighing. Listen to my cry for help, my King and my God, for to you I pray. **In the morning, O LORD, you hear my voice...**”
Psalm 5:1-3a

Lesson Two: In the face of hard things, we have the right to make **specific requests** of Father God.

“In the morning, O LORD, you hear my voice; in the morning **I lay my requests before you...**” Psalm 5:3a

Lesson Three: As we make our requests, we need to **wait expectantly** for Father God’s answer.

“In the morning, O LORD, you hear my voice; in the morning I lay my requests before you and **wait in expectation**” Psalm 5:3

Note: We wait in expectation because of God’s consistent **promise** to hear and respond.

Lesson Four: Father God’s answer is **always** a **blessing** for us.

“For surely, O LORD, **you bless the righteous; you surround them with your favor** as with a shield.” Psalm 5:12

- Father God blesses us when he answers **“yes”**.
- Father God blesses us when he answers **“no”**.
- Father God blesses us when he answers **“wait”**.

The Bottom Line: Our job is to ask God for what we want, wait expectantly and then **trust** that his answer is the **best** answer possible.
